The history of Cenobio dei Dogi goes back a long way, in fact as far back as 1565 when the aristocratic Dogi family decided to build a villa on the rocks at the foot of Portofino mountain. Years later it passed into the hands of Emilio De Ferrari whose dream was to turn the villa into a luxury hotel where people could come from all over the world to enjoy and appreciate the peace, beauty and elegance of the place he so loved. Sadly he died before his dream was realized but his devoted wife, Adelia, and their children managed to fulfill the dream and in 1956 Cenobio dei Dogi was born. The hotel soon became well-known as one of the finest hotels of Liguria where guests could immerse themselves in a corner of paradise and has remained privately owned to this day.

Set within a park of pine trees and exotic flowers, Cenobio dei Dogi is a wonderful destination for nature lovers. Walks amidst the lush Mediterranean vegetation, boat trips along this stunning coastline to Portofino, the Cinque Terre, Genoa and San Fruttuoso plus diving in the crystal waters make Cenobio ideal as a place in which to relax and unwind. Staff at Cenobio dei Dogi are charming, friendly and efficient and guests can choose to eat in a variety of restaurants at the hotel itself or else just simply wander along the pretty streets of Camogli to one of the many local restaurants serving typical Ligurian specialities. Camogli derives its name from the phrase "Le case delle Mogli" (the houses of the wives) due to the fact that in the old days the fishermen spent so long at sea leaving the village to their wives, children and the elderly. Today, Camogli is still as charming as ever with an enchanting atmosphere of ease, beautifully maintained and yet unspoilt.

Rooms at Cenobio dei Dogi are all spacious and well appointed but of course a room with a sea view is ideal! Light and airy and furnished in keeping with a seaside property, many also enjoy balconies and terraces from which guests can watch the magical sunsets across the Mediterranean with a chilled glass of Ligurian wine.
