This 12th century ruined watchtower has been lovingly restored and transformed by its quite fabulous owners into a contemporary retreat of outstanding architectural design to THE very highest of standards. Inside and out are both equally beautiful and throughout the property there is a really special feeling of tranquility and peace.

After many years of extremely hard work, impressive dedication, thoughtful and intuitive design and admirable consideration for the surrounding environment, Torre Moravola was created and offers guests a quite unique experience. From outside to inside the emphasis is on the natural world reflected in the water, stone, wood, and choice of linens and fabrics. This is nurtured by minimising the impact of the environmental footprint of Moravola on its surroundings through the use of renewable energy sources and an attention to the importance of sustainability.







There are seven suites, five are designed as "tower suites" arranged in an open plan design over two levels. On the ground level there are sunken stone baths, showers and toilets and direct private access to the exterior terraces. The upper level affords complete privacy and awe inspiring views over the surrounding valleys. Throughout there is a sense of calm and space and with so many choices of places to sit and just 'be' both inside and outside, Moravola



It is also a place to gather with friends and chat with an aperitivi beneath the pool pavilion or maybe on the soft comfy sofas of the West Pavilion, on the East Terrace looking across the valley or in one of the warmly decorated and styled sitting rooms of the main tower. Throughout Moravola, the very best top quality products have been used be it in the building materials and bathroom fittings, be it the soft furnishings and bathroom toiletries.

The 25 metre pool cannot fail to impress and certainly stands out to me as one of the most beautiful I have ever seen. The contemporary Asian design has been ingeniously moulded into a medieval and natural ambience and guests will simply love spending lazy afternoons here with a book after perhaps a morning activity or sightseeing to one the many fascinating nearby medieval towns of which there is ample choice although, to be honest, many will not manage to pull themselves away from the paradise of Moravola.

Dining at Torre Moravola is yet another memorable highlight. Using the very best locally sourced ingredients, Christopher (chef and architect!) has a magical way with food and guests can enjoy delicious, healthy Italian recipes as well as some exotic and mouth watering Asian specialities.. the fusion here works!

The latest addition at Moravola is the Forest Spa. Natural healing practices of the pre Roman Umbri tribes inspired the newly completed Spa, with an inner courtyard and heated stone plunge pool, a Marble Hammam and Finnish sauna, transporting views through the Oak forest into the valley. The Spa and treatments are booked privately depending on availability for a maximum of four people and treatments can be designed according to client's requests and needs. In addition, the Forest Spa can be also be booked as a private accommodation with its sliding









glass walls and surrounding oak trees with views over the East valley.

However many nights one stays at Moravola it won't be enough! Ideal as the destination within a tailor made itinerary passing through Umbria for a few nights Moravola is also available in exclusivity as a villa for private groups and also as a wedding destination.
